INTRODUCTION:

Ecclesiastes 10:18, Through sloth the roof sinks in, and through indolence the house leaks.

Matthew 24:43, But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into.

Matthew 6:19, "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal,

Matthew 12:29, Or how can someone enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man? Then indeed he may plunder his house.

Hebrews 9:27, And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment,

Revelation 21:4, He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away."

Revelation 21:27, But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Revelation 22:15, Outside are the dogs and sorcerers and the sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.

1 John 4:8, Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

III. OUR ETERNAL HOME?:

2 Corinthians 5:6-8, 6) So we are always of good courage. We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, 7) for we walk by faith, not by sight. 8) Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord.

III. OUR ETERNAL HOME?:

1 John 3:1, See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are. The reason why the world does not know us is that it did not know him.

Philippians 1:21-24, 21) For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. 22) If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell. 23) I am hard pressed between the two. My desire is to depart and be with Christ, for that is far better. 24) But to remain in the flesh is more necessary on your account.
