Galatians 5:1

1. Lawlessness or Licentiousness

- “My salvation is entirely dependent on the righteousness of Christ; therefore I have a license to sin as much as I want to.”
- “Sin is really no big deal because salvation is based on the unconditional promises of God.”

2. Legalism or Self-justification

- “My salvation is entirely dependent on my own personal righteousness; therefore I have an obligation to justify myself by law-keeping.”
- “Law-keeping is everything because salvation is based on the conditional promises of God.”
