# A Restored Mind.



# Four Human Gifts.


- Self awareness: The Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry, and why has your face fallen?" Genesis 4:6

# Old Man vs New Man




And Nabal answered... "Shall I take my bread and my water and my meat that I have killed for my shearers and give it to men who come from I do not know where?"

1 Sam 25:10-11




And David said to his men, "Every man strap on his sword!"

1 Sam 25:13




"...and he is such a worthless man that one cannot **speak** to him." 1 Sam 25:17




Then Abigail made haste... 25:18

When Abigail saw David, she hurried and got down from the donkey and fell before David on her face and bowed to the ground. 25:23


She fell at his feet and said, "On me alone, my lord, be the guilt." 25:24
